

# JK RELAYS 2008



## General Information

The Relays are being held on **Monday 24 March 2008** at **Eridge**, a traditional Estates parkland 5 miles south of Tunbridge Wells with access from A267 south of Frant. Sorry, but **NO DOGS**, even in vehicles, at the Estates office stipulation. As a condition of land use, all individual competitors will be required to sign a disclaimer on Day 4 which states "I accept that I take part in all activities in Eridge Park at my own risk and that the Estate does not accept any liability for any loss, damage or accident howsoever caused". Club Captains should ensure that team members are aware of this. For competitors under age 18, Club Captains will be asked to obtain these disclaimers from parents or guardians at or, if they are not attending, in advance of the event and bring them to Relay Registration.

# JK 2008 - RELAYS

## Explanation of Classes and Entry Fees

1. For age restricted relay classes (E to L), use the sum of the competitors' age classes applicable for the 2008 calendar year. The sum must be equal to or greater than (Classes E, F, G, H), or equal to or less than (Classes J, K, L) the cumulative "age" stipulated for the Class. Do not use the actual ages of the competitors for this purpose. [ e.g. M45 + M65 + M55 = 165 ]
2. For junior classes (J, K, and L) no entrant may be above M/W 20.
3. For the Mini Relay (class M) all entrants must be M/W 12 or below.
4. Class N is open to teams (M and/or W) comprising members of different clubs.
5. Laps will be run in the order shown except for class N (Mixed Ad Hoc) which will have lap lengths jumbled up. The running order will be shown on the Team Declaration Form.
6. Junior fees will apply to Junior classes only. Juniors running in any class other than J, K, L, M will be charged the same entry as a Senior runner in that class. (i.e. the entry fee applies to the relay class entered, not to an individual runner).
7. The Mini Relay is technical level 2.
8. To be competitive in classes A to M all runners must be from the same club (UK or overseas) or (for classes A and B only) be members of an approved Neighbouring Club Alliance under BOF Guideline M.

## Electronic Punching

SI punching will be used for all relay races. Each relay runner must use the SI "dibber" declared at Relay Registration. SI dibbers must **NOT** be exchanged between runners or used for more than one relay run. If any of your competitors do not have their own SI dibber, they can be hired for the Relay day at a charge of £1 each through Relay Registration at Days 2 and 3 of the event. The additional £1 is payable irrespective of whether a dibber has been hired and paid for the individual days.

## Entries

**The closing date for entries is 7 March 2008** - Any entries received (for web entries) or postmarked (for postal entries) after this date will be accepted subject to the availability of maps so please do not depend on this, as you may be disappointed.

A limited number of Ad Hoc team entries will be available at Relay Registration on days 2 and 3.

For UK entrants this information and Entry Form is also being sent to Club Secretaries.

## **On-line relay entries (preferred)**

Please enter JK2008 relays via the internet if possible. The electronic entry will be available from late-January. The payment system is secure.

Team captains will also be able to enter team details on-line before the event between 12 and 19 March (preferred) or by handing in a team declaration form at Relay Registration on Days 2 and 3. Further information will be given at the time of issuance of these forms.
